

2-Day Marrakech to Zagora Desert Tour: A Popular Choice

Sign up for a private two-day excursion from Marrakech to the Zagora Desert and discover the wonders of the southern Sahara. The Zagora Desert, being the closest to Marrakech, is the true gateway to the Sahara.

Although the Zagora Desert doesn't boast high sand dunes like Erg Chebbi or Erg Chigaga, it nonetheless offers an excellent option for a camel ride and spending the night under the stars in a comfortable desert camp.

Admire the breathtaking landscapes as you cross the spectacular Atlas Mountains, visit the UNESCO World Heritage site of Ait-Ben-Haddou, embark on a camel trek, and spend the night in a desert camp.

Day 1: Marrakech - Atlas Mountains - Ait Benhaddou – Zagora

After breakfast at your hotel/riad, we will pick you up at 8:00 AM for our private two-day desert excursion from Marrakech to Zagora. You will cross the spectacular Atlas Mountains and can make stops for photos, visit an argan oil cooperative, or simply relax.

After crossing the Tizi n'Tichka pass (2,260 m), we will reach the spectacular site of Ait-Ben-Haddou, where we will enjoy a guided walking tour of this unique architectural masterpiece. Ait-Ben-Haddou consists of numerous kasbahs (fortresses) forming a remarkable example of southern architecture, with its four towers, high walls, and small windows.

After lunch, we continue our two-day desert excursion from Marrakech to Zagora, crossing the impressive Anti-Atlas Mountains and the lush Drâa palm valley, before arriving in Zagora in the late afternoon.

Embark on a camel trek through the arid desert and admire the breathtaking sunset. Upon arrival at the camp, you will have dinner under the stars in a romantic setting, or inside the tent restaurant, before spending a restful night in your tent.

Day 2: Zagora - Ouarzazate – Marrakech

Return to Marrakech

- A camel ride to admire the sunset.
